- Abstracts should be submitted electronically only through the Conference website [www.PIBD2009.com](http://www.PIBD2009.com)
- Abstracts should be submitted according to the instructions detailed on the website and by the specified deadline.
- Abstracts received after the deadline cannot be accepted and will therefore not be considered for the programme or publication.
- All abstracts must be written in English.
- When submitting your abstract, choose the topic it most relates to (please refer to list below). The Abstract Selection Committee will decide on definitive topic assignment upon abstract selection.
- Abstracts will be selected for oral or poster presentation. A preference for poster presentation can be indicated although the Scientific Committee will make the final decision as to how the abstract will be presented.
- Abstracts will be peer reviewed without knowledge of their source. Acceptance or rejection of an abstract will be based on the average mark awarded by the reviewers.
- Submission of an abstract implies the commitment that the presenting author will attend the PIBD 2009 Congress and the expectation that financial resources to attend are available.
- Accepted abstracts will be published in a Gastroenterology Journal.
- The presenting author must register to the Conference in order for the accepted abstracts to be published as mentioned above.

- Type or cut and paste your abstract. Only include your abstract body text, the title and authors line will automatically be pulled in the text from the information provided above.
- The following subdivisions of your abstract are recommended but are NOT MANDATORY:
  - # Background
  - # Objectives
  - # Methods
  - # Conclusions
  - # References
- The total length of the abstract should not exceed 1700 printable characters (including spaces). Please do not add line breaks within the body text of the abstract.
- Tables and/or graphs are not accepted.
- If you need to enter Greek letters or use bold, italics or superscript/subscript then you may use our special text editor by clicking on the 'edit' button.
- Please note that you will have to preview your abstract before submission.
- It will be possible to modify your abstract by pressing the “Edit abstract “ button. To submit your abstract, press the “save/submit” button.
